

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 80-10

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY
AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES TO ASSIST
IN THE OPERATION OF A COORDINATED PROGRAM FOR WATER QUALITY
SURVEILLANCE AND MONITORING

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board has the responsibility to coordinate water quality-related investigations of state agencies and to conduct necessary water quality monitoring activities.
2. The multi-agency "Memorandum of Understanding" was executed on August 27, 1974, between the State Board and the Departments of Water Resources, Fish and Game, and Health for the purpose of coordinating data management and water quality-related data collection programs of various state agencies.
3. The State Board, with the concurrence of the Regional Boards, has completed development and design of a state-wide monitoring network, has implemented that network pursuant to State Board Resolution No. 76-57, and intends to continue operation of said program, pursuant to authority granted under Section 13001 and the directive under Section 13163 of the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act, for a coordinated water quality control program.
4. The Department of Water Resources has the staff and technical capability to provide the specified services and desires to provide such services to the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board's Executive Director is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Water Resources to assist in the operation of a coordinated program for water quality surveillance and monitoring for an amount not to exceed \$160,000 for the period July 1, 1980, through June 30, 1981, subject to the availability of funds.
