ACCEPTANCE OF A SECTION 104(b)(3) GRANT FOR NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES)
STORM WATER PROGRAM-RELATED PROJECTS

WHEREAS:

- 1. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) announced the availability of up to \$630,000 in Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1994 grant funding under Section 104(b)(3) of the Clean Water Act for research and special projects in support of the implementation of the NPDES Storm Water Program.
- 2. The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) has applied to USEPA for a FFY 1994 Section 104(b)(3) grant in support of the NPDES Storm Water Program.
- 3. The proposed work is of high priority and will assist the SWRCB in implementing and managing its NPDES Storm Water Program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board:

Authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to accept an offer by USEPA for a FFY 1994 Section 104(b)(3) grant in the amount of \$630,000 for NPDES Storm Water Program-related projects.
