

**STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD  
RESOLUTION NO. 2015-0007**

**AMEND THE POLICY FOR IMPLEMENTING THE CLEAN WATER  
STATE REVOLVING FUND (CWSRF)**

**WHEREAS:**

1. The Division of Financial Assistance (Division) administers the CWSRF Program to provide low-cost financing for publicly owned treatment works, including wastewater treatment facilities, sanitary sewer collection systems, sewer interceptors, and water reclamation facilities, to implement programs and projects to control pollution from nonpoint sources and storm water drainage, and to develop and implement estuary cleanup programs;
2. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) originally adopted the *Policy for Implementing the Clean Water State Revolving Fund* (CWSRF Policy) on August 18, 1988, and has amended it periodically;
3. The federal Water Resources Reform and Development Act (WRRDA) of 2014 made changes to the federal Clean Water Act, resulting in changes to the Clean Water State Revolving Fund program, effective October 1, 2014; and
4. Changes from WRRDA consistent with state law have been incorporated into the draft CWSRF Policy.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

The State Water Board amends the CWSRF Policy as shown in Exhibits [A](#) and [B](#).

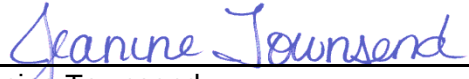
